"JAHRI SALEH ZOO"

This animal park that is also known by the name of Jahri Saleh Zoo has plenty of animals that can be viewed by visitors. There are varieties of birds in this mini zoo such as pigeons, crows, hornbills, ornamental chickens, and so forth. Then there are also crocodiles, reptiles and several species of primates such as the proboscis monkey and langur. The visitors could freely look around the animals every day from 08:00 am until 18:00 pm.



"FLOATING MARKET"

In Banjarmasin, south Kalimantan, there are a hundreds rivers that become the important transportation route until now. The tourism objects focus on the river, like floating market of Muara Kuin in Banjarmasin city. When the sun rises, go to this market that reflect the light in the morning between the transactions of vegetables and crops from villages along Barito river and its tributaries.

"MUSEUM WASAKA"

Interested to know and learn the history of the struggle people of South Kalimantan? Come to the Museum Wasaka in H. Andir street, Kampung Kenanga, Ulu Sungai Jingah Village, Banjarmasin Utara Distruct of Banjarmasin. The museum is located on the banks of Martapura River, adjoining the bridge 17 Mei (Banua Anyar Bridge) that large, long and sturdy.

Wasaka itself derived from Waja Sampai Ka Putting that means incessant struggle to the death. That sentence is the slogan of the struggle people of South Kalimantan. Wasaka Museum was inaugurated on November 10, 1991, in the house of Banjar Bubungan Tinggi then converted from a residential into a museum. This is done as one of the traditional buildings conservation efforts.

"MENARA PANDANG"

Relax with family is the dream of many people. Needed a safe place for it, and of course, fun and affordable. One of the favorite recreational places in Banjarmasin is Taman Siring Menara Pandang (Park Siring View Tower) at Jalan Kapten Pierre Tendean, Banjarmasin. Parks that adorn the banks of River Siring Martapura is always crowded with citizens or tourists. In this garden overgrown with trees so shady and cool atmosphere. The trees here manifold buttresses of land along the river such as tamarind that was deliberately planted by Banjarmasin City government that sustainable streams.

Taman Siring Menara Pandang (Park Siring View Tower) is known as the new icon of Banjarmasin City. The viewing tower is clearly visible from the side of Martapura River. You can get into the tower and enjoy the view of the river and Banjarmasin City. It was inaugurated in June 2014 with height of 21 meters and a cost of IDR 14.5 billion is expected to become a new icon of Banjarmasin City.
